

Clear Hallways/Tardy Policy 2023-2024

At Milwood Middle School, we are dedicated to creating a safe and orderly environment where our students can focus their attention on academics. Students are expected to be in class on time each and every day. Students are allotted four minutes to get from one class to another. This is enough time for students to move efficiently from one end of the building to another. To ensure that we maintain a safe and orderly environment we will be instituting and following the tardy/ clear hallway policy below.

Tardy Policy

- Upon the first violation parents will be notified of the student's infraction.
- A second violation will result in an after school detention, where they will have a chance to make up academic work and be provided with support on their assignments.
- A third violation will result in a one day out of school suspension.
- Each six weeks the tardies will reset to zero.

Safe and Clear Hallway Policy

- Students are not permitted to leave the classroom the first or last ten minutes
 of class.
- Any student outside of the classroom must be escorted by an adult or have a valid pass from a teacher.
- Students in the hallways without a pass/escort will be subject to a referral,
 which may result in a detention, or suspension.

We are committed to ensuring that the students are provided with a safe and orderly academic environment, where learning is the primary focus of our students.
