



Maple Street Middle School is pleased to offer a ski and snowboard club this winter. **NO TRANSPORTATION** will be provided from Maple Street. The assigned day for the club will be on Friday's from 5pm - close. With Wednesday's being a short day for students, many families will be attending that day, however the club advisors will not always be able to make it on Wednesday's because of previous school related requirements.

How the program works:

- Buy a punch card for each skier or snowboarder in your family - **Parents and siblings are encouraged to join as well!**
- Use the punch card each time you go to Timber Ridge for discounted lift tickets and ski rental.

Cost: \$25 for a student ski club membership punch card
\$25 for an adult ski club membership punch card

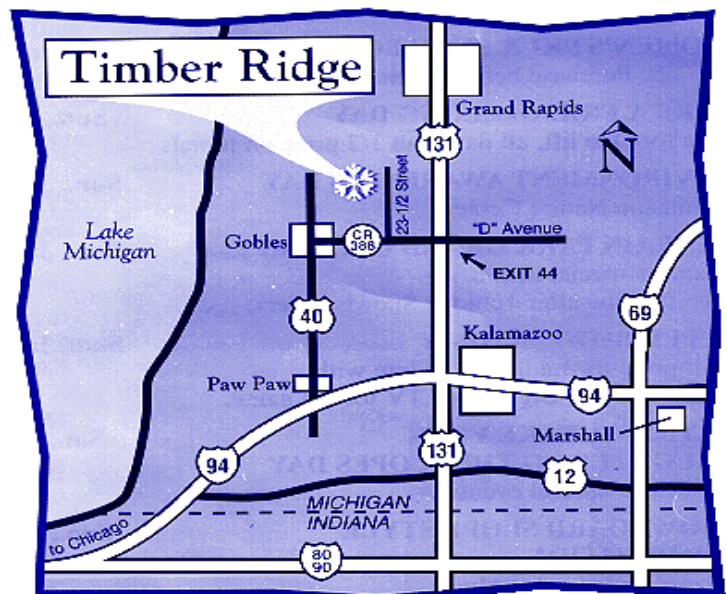
Once you purchase your punch card you will receive:

- **Students:** \$16 lift ticket and \$16 rental anytime (each visit) (\$18 lift savings!)
- **Adult punch cards:** \$16 lift tickets and \$16 ski rentals Mon.-Fri. (Non-Holiday). (\$24 lift savings!) \$22 Lift tickets and \$16 ski rentals Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays. (\$28 lift savings!)
- One punch per day.

We will start meeting at Timber Ridge on Friday, January 8th, but you can start using your punch card as soon as Timber Ridge is open for business.

For guardians who do not ski, there is a lounge area where you can relax and watch the skiers, however occupancy may be limited due to potential COVID-19 restrictions. Restrictions are to be determined.

If you are looking for ski lessons (7yrs and up), please contact us at a later date as that information is unavailable at this time. If lessons do become available, they will start up on Friday, January 8th.
