Dear Loy Norrix Families,

It is hard to believe that it is time to begin selecting courses for the 2020-2021 school year. We will continue to use Home Access Center (HAC) for the online course selection process. This means that students will log into their HAC account and select the courses they would like to take next school year. Students will be given a copy of the district course bulletin along with their transcript to assist in the selection of courses. Your student will also receive a paper course selection sheet. We ask that students complete this form to match what they have selected online and drop it off in the counseling office by Monday, February 3, 2020.

The course selection window in HAC will open for all students on Monday, January 27, 2020. Counselors will be available during parent teacher conferences on January 29 and 30 to help students. Students may also email their counselor or stop into the counseling office to set up an appointment if they need additional help with the process.

Students who do not complete the online selection process or return the course selection sheet by February 21, 2020 will be delayed in the course selection process. It is extremely important that you meet this deadline in order to have the best opportunity to be placed in all the courses you desire.

We have created a scheduling video to assist you and your student in the online scheduling process. The link to the video is listed below and can be found on the school's website as well. We will also be placing a copy of the 2020-2021 course bulletin online. The course bulletin lists graduation requirements, county programs, and course descriptions for courses offered at Loy Norrix. Courses that do not have sufficient requests will be canceled and students requesting that course will be scheduled into an alternative.

We truly hope this online approach will facilitate a smooth scheduling process and allow you to participate and engage in conversation with your student about their course selections and high school academic career.
