# GENERAL INFORMATION

- Elementary specials start the week of September 8th, 2020
- Elementary students who selected Option 1 must attend 2 or more specials (art, music, PE) each week
- Students will have the choice to attend scheduled livestream classes or complete recorded lessons in their own time
- Students will submit a codeword each week for attendance

# HOW WILL LIVE SPECIALS WORK?

Specials classes are offered via Google Livestream several times each week. It is a 'drop in' style, where students may choose which time frames work best for them each week. Most classes are offered at 8:50, 9:30, 2:50 & 3:30 each day. There are no afternoon specials classes on Fridays. Please check your [grade level specials website](#) for exact schedule & links.

Students will watch and participate in the lesson. At some point during the lesson, the teacher will share a **codeword**. The student will enter the codeword on the grade level specials website.

# HOW WILL RECORDED LESSONS WORK?

Independent lessons will be available by Monday of each week on the [grade level specials website](#). Hidden within the lesson will be a codeword. Students will submit the codeword on the website when the lesson is completed. Recorded lessons can be completed at any time during the week. They contain the same content as the 'live' lessons.

# WHAT SHOULD MY FAMILY DO NEXT?

1. Visit your grade level specials website (your student will need to be logged into a KPS account):

2. Watch video on website
3. Decide how & when your child will participate
4. Change your mind at any time
5. Attend at least two different specials per week
6. Enter the codeword on the website for each special attended. This is how attendance will be monitored.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Does my child need to register for class? No. The student will either be present for a livestream or complete a recorded lesson. Student must complete the CODEWORD form to earn credit for participating in either livestream or recorded lessons.
- How do I know who will teach my children? Visit the grade level specials website. Each teacher has an introduction video and contact information.
- Can families attend sessions together? Yes. Students of different grade levels may attend one session together (ex: 4th grader attends 2nd grade lesson with their sibling). Be aware, however, that content may be too hard or too easy when you are choosing different grade levels. We encourage each student to go to their grade level specials, if possible.
- What is the general questions form? If you have general questions about specials, ask here. If the question is specific to your child's teacher, please email them directly. All of this information can be found on the 'contact teachers' tab.
